### DARE Objectives

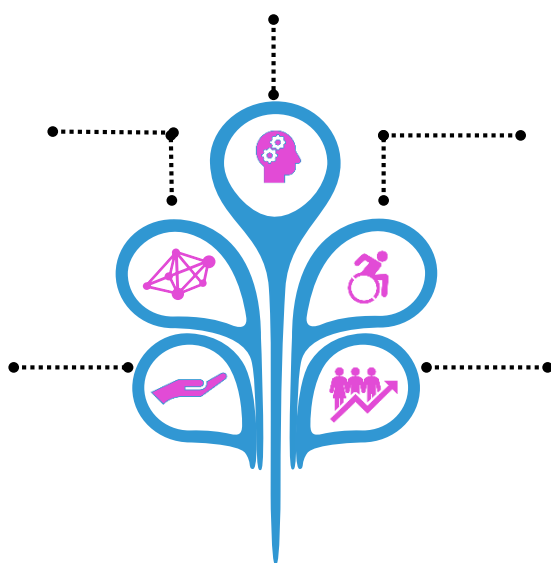
Support the capacity building of youth workers and youth organisations in implementing high quality youth mobility inclusive projects involving young PwVHPI
