**Third transnational meeting of inspiring FLIMCO project
takes place in Schlierbach, Austria**

The 3rd transnational meeting of **the Financial Literacy in Marginalised Communities (FLIMCO) project (Erasmus+ KA2)** will take place in **Schlierbach, Austria** and it will be hosted by **SPES Zukunftsakademie**, on the 24th and 25th September.

The main topics of discussion will be the progress of the development of the third intellectual output: the online e-course for financial literacy for marginalized communities, refugees and NEETs. Each project partner has already conducted, for its own country, a preliminary research, on the existing platforms designed with similar purposes as the FLIMCO partners referred to in the proposal. The goal is to create a free, intuitive and easy to use platform.

FLIMCO's e-course on financial literacy will provide the project target groups (marginalised communities, refugees, NEETs and VET organizations and trainers) with the possibility to increase their own financial literacy directly through an interesting, interactive and up to date e-course. It will focus on the real financial literacy needs of the groups mentioned above. The e-course will be hosted within the project website.

Other project products are: a **Handbook on the relationship between financial literacy and cultural norms** and a **Framework for a financial literacy curriculum**.

The next transnational project meeting of the FLIMCO project will take place in Poland in March 2020, with Danmar as the host.

FLIMCO project is funded under Key Action 2 of the Erasmus+ Programme. Key Action 2 provides opportunities organisations to work in partnership with European colleagues.
