B-LAND

The adult education presents specific views about learning and teaching based on the assumption that adults can and want to learn, that they are able and willing to take responsibility for that learning, and that the learning itself should respond to their needs. Educating adults differs from educating children - adults have accumulated knowledge and work experience which can add to the learning experience.

The adult education makes the following assumptions about the design of learning:

- 1. Adults need to know why they need to learn something,
- 2. Adults need to learn experientially,
- 3. Adults approach learning as problem-solving,
- 4. Adults learn best when the topic is of immediate value.

In practical terms, it means that instruction for adults needs to focus more on the process and less on the content being taught. Strategies such as case studies, role playing, simulations, and self-evaluation are most useful.
