- To upgrade teachers' skills, as well as enhance their teaching methodologies and tools so that they can contribute to the protection of the environment.

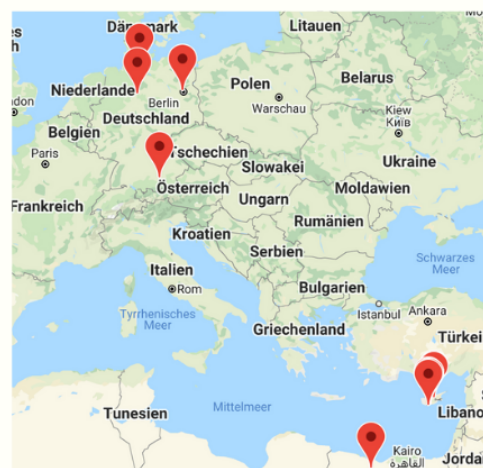

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# THE SCHOOLS GO GREEN BAROMETER
