We are proud of the progress underway in the **Green Read** project. The most important issue discussed in this **newsletter** is the **Mockup** structure.

As part of the Mockup process, we create prototypes of our training materials, which we then present to participants for testing and evaluation. The testing helps us identify potential problems, shortcomings, or areas for improvement, allowing us to adjust the materials before final implementation. This process requires active participation and involvement from users for us to deliver the highest quality and most useful training materials.



The Mockup platform is complete of:

1. The **Case Study** that allows participants to understand real-world applications of training materials and their impact on professional practice.

2. The **Assessment** - is to verify that the platform meets users' expectations and that successfully the training materials have been created.

3. The Course is divided into the following skills:



- Cognitive competencies, you can find the followina trainina materials: raising environmental awareness and а willingness to learn about sustainable development, systems, and risk analysis skills + Monitoring skills, Innovation skills to identify opportunities and create new strategies to respond to green challenges + Growth mindset, Critical thinking (Green washing vs Real Green), Material use and impact quantification
- · Inter-personal skills you can find the following training materials: Coordination, management, and business skills facilitate holistic to and interdisciplinary approaches that encompass economic, social. and ecological objectives, Communication and negotiation skills for discussion of conflicting interests in complex contexts, Marketing skills to promote greener products and services. Procurement and Selection, Green digital skills.



 Intra-personal competencies, you can find the following training materials: Adaptability and transferable skills to enable workers to learn and apply new technologies and processes required to green their jobs, Entrepreneurial skills to seize opportunities presented by lowcarbon technologies, Leadership skills + decision making, Employability skills, Team working skills.
